


Organization Chart

Date of Occurrence: March 5, 2014 @ 1215 hrs.

On Wednesday, March 5, 2014, at approximately 12:15 p.m. PFC Mitchell was conducting speed enforcement on Dupont Road in the area of South Cleveland. He stopped a vehicle for speeding on Dupont Road. The driver was identified as D1 Anthony Seeney of the unit block of Aidone Drive, New Castle. D-1 was acting suspiciously and was appeared to be highly nervous. Upon further investigation PFC Mitchell discovered D-1 had a loaded 45 cal. Beretta p4 storm handgun under the front driver seat of his vehicle.

D1 was charged with speeding in excess of posted limits and carrying a concealed deadly weapon. D1 was arraigned by JP Court #2 and given a total of \$2,501 unsecured bond. D1 was released as a result.

Date of Occurrence: March 23, 2014 @ 0215 hrs.

On Sunday, March 23, 2014, at approximately 2:15 a.m. PFC Mitchell and PFC Kerrigan responded to Rt. 2 E/B and Western Avenue for a PI Accident. Upon arrival they located the operator of vehicle #1 trapped and semi-conscious. The operator of vehicle #2 (Seal) was conscious and complaining of abdominal injuries. Both drivers were transported to Christiana Hospital. Operator #1 (Clark) died from her injuries and operator #2 underwent surgery. Operator #2 (Seal) was later charged with Driving Under the Influence.

Date of Occurrence: April 8, 2014 @ 1330 hrs.

On Tuesday, April 8, 2014, at approximately 1:30 p.m. Elsmere police stopped D-1 (Archie) in the unit block of Tamarack Avenue. During the stop officers patted down the subject for officer safety and located one log (130 bags) of Heroin in his jacket.

Officers later executed a warrant on D-1's residence in the 1300 block of Cypress Avenue and seized 11.9 grams of crack cocaine, various prescriptions not prescribed to the defendant and drug paraphernalia.

Defendant #1: DeJuan Archie of the 1300 blk. Of Cypress Avenue, Elsmere, DE was charged with 2 Cts. of Manufactures, delivers, or PWID a controlled substance in a Tier 2, 2 Cts. of Possession Consume any Prescription Drug not Controlled Substance w/o a Prescription and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

D-1 (Archie) was arraigned by Justice of the Peace Court #11 and received a total of \$5,000 secured bond. D-1 was committed to the Howard Young Correctional Institute.

Date of Occurrence: April 10, 2014

On Thursday, April 10, 2014, two juvenile victims responded to the police station with their parents to report a late robbery that occurred on April 9, 2014 on Bungalow Avenue. Victims reported that three unknown black male subjects followed them from Baltz Elementary School to Bungalow Avenue. When they reached Bungalow Avenue the one victim was assaulted and a cell phone was taken.

During the investigation PFC Kerrigan put together a 6 pack photo lineup. The victim positively identified one of the suspects.

A warrant for Robbery 1st and Conspiracy 2nd was secured for the juvenile suspect. PFC Kerrigan and B-Squad members also executed a search warrant in the 1400 Blk. of Sycamore Avenue. During the search warrant the juvenile suspect was taken into custody and the property taken in the robbery was recovered.

As a result of the investigation all three suspects have been arrested. These same suspects were arrested by New Castle County PD for similar crimes.

Date of Occurrence: June 11, 2014 @ 0700 hrs.

On Wednesday, June 11, 2014, Elsmere police executed four search warrants throughout various locations in New Castle County. As a result of a continuing drug investigation officers seized over fifteen pounds of marijuana including 322 grams of DABS which totals a street value of \$50,000. Also seized was 24,000 in US Currency, Ecstasy pills, cocaine and three vehicles.

The following individuals were arrested for the following:

Colin P. Carroll (DOB: 5/10/73) of the 1600 blk. of Newport Gap Pike, Wilmington was charged with Possesses a Controlled Substance (2 cts), Possession w/Intent to Deliver, Maintaining a Drug Property and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. Def. Carroll was arraigned by JP Court 11 and released on \$29,200 unsecured bond.

Jennifer L. Damico (DOB: 4/13/85) of the 100 block of Westmont Avenue, Wilmington was charged with Possession w/Intent to Deliver and Possesses a Controlled Substance. Def. Damico was arraigned by JP Court 11 and committed on \$20,000 secured bond.

William R. Roe (DOB: 7/30/84) of the 100 block of Westmont Avenue, Wilmington was charged with Possession w/Intent to Deliver and Possesses a Controlled Substance. Def. Roe was arraigned by JP Court 11 and released on \$20,000 unsecured bond.

Thomas J. Radcliffe (DOB: 9/14/92) of the 2100 block of Jackson Avenue, Wilmington was charged with Possession of Marijuana. Def. Radcliffe was arraigned by JP Court 11 and released on \$100 unsecured bond.

Date of Occurrence: July 6, 2014 @ 1630 hrs.

Cpl. John Mitchell, III conducted a motor vehicle stop for a seatbelt violation in the area of the Rt. 2 & Rt. 100. The driver was identified as Valencio Hinton of the Unit Blk. of Fairway Road, Newark, DE.

During the stop Cpl. Mitchell located a book bag containing a loaded 12 gauge sawed-off shotgun. Def. Hinton was charged with Possession of Marijuana with an aggravating factor, Possession of a Deadly Weapon by Person Prohibited and Possession of a Destructive Weapon.

Def. Hinton was arraigned by Justice of the Peace Court 11 and released on a \$2,900 unsecured bond.

Date of Occurrence: July 24, 2014 @ 1000 hrs.

Ptlm. West conducted a motor vehicle stop for a seatbelt violation in the 900 block of Kirkwood Highway. The occupant of the vehicle was identified as 28 year old Blane Moxley of the 200 block of North Dupont Street in Wilmington, DE.

During the stop a 9mm pistol which was reported stolen from a residential burglary in 2010 was recovered along with marijuana. A subsequent search of his home, uncovered a loaded .357 Magnum revolver and additional ammunition.

Def. Blane was charged with 2 counts of Possession of a Weapon by Person Prohibited, Receiving a Stolen Firearm and Possession of Marijuana. Def. Blanes bail was set at \$12,501.00 secured and \$3,100.00 cash. The defendant was committed to the Howard Young Correctional facility in lieu of bail.

Date of Occurrence: July 25, 2014 @ 0050 hrs.

Cpl. Mitchell & PFC Giles were dispatched to the Dogwood Hollow Development for a possible vehicle theft in progress. Two suspects identified as 33 year old Johnny Hunter of the 2600 Block of North Monroe Street, Wilmington and 18 year old Donmier Peters of the 800 Block of North Harrison Street, Wilmington,

As officers approached on foot they observed the suspects attempting to steal a vehicle. The suspects fled on foot, but were caught after a brief foot chase. The investigation determined that the two suspects were stealing items from vehicles in the area and attempted to use a spare key located in one of the vehicles and attempt to steal it.

Both suspects were charged with Burglary 3rd, Conspiracy 2nd, and attempted theft of a motor vehicle, possession of burglary tools, night prowling, and resisting arrest. Both subjects received \$4,500.00 unsecured bail and were issued a no contact order with the Town of Elsmere.

Date of Occurrence: August 17, 2014 @ 0015 hrs.

On Sunday, August 17th, 2014 the Elsmere Bureau of Police responded to the 2700 Block of Boulevard Road for the report of a home invasion. As a result of the investigation a search warrant was executed today August 18, 2014 by the Wilmington SWAT team and the Elsmere Bureau of Police at 0600 in the 1100 Block of Rodman Road. Taken into custody as a result of the warrant were 20 year old JayJuan Craig and 18 year old Daveion Johnson both reside in the 1100 Block of Rodman Road. Evidence recovered as a result of the search warrant linked both subjects to the home invasion.

Daveion Johnson was charged with Possession of Marijuana with an aggravating factor, Possession of a Controlled Substance, Assault Third Degree, Conspiracy Second Degree, Possession of a deadly weapon by a person prohibited, Possession of a destructive weapon, Aggravated menacing, Possession of a weapon with a obliterated serial number, Home invasion, Possession of a Firearm During the Commission of a felony, and Robbery First Degree. Daveion was committed to the Howard Young correctional Facility in lieu of \$209,200.00 cash bail.

JayJuan Craig was charged with Offensive Touching, Possession of a Deadly Weapon By a person prohibited, Aggravated Menacing, Home Invasion, Possession of a firearm during the commission of a felony, and Robbery first degree. JayJuan was committed to the Howard Young Correctional facility in lieu of \$189,100.00 cash bond.

Date of Occurrence: September 15, 2014 @ 1420 hrs.

On Monday, September 15, 2014, at approximately 1420 hrs. officers from Elsmere PD and New Castle County PD responded to the 2100 block of Seneca Road for a report of two subjects shot. Upon arrival officers located two males with gunshot wounds. Both victims were transported to Christiana Hospital where one was listed in critical and one in stable condition. Witnesses reported seeing a black male wearing a black hooded sweatshirt running E/B on S. Grant Avenue after the shooting.

Due to numerous hours of dedication, Lt. Shelton was able to gather enough evidence to arrest two suspects; Darren Staats and Reynaldo Diaz for Attempted Murder 1st, Assault 1st, Possession of a Firearm During the Commission of a Felony, Carrying a Concealed Weapon and Conspiracy.

Date of Occurrence: November 3, 2014 @ 1230 hrs.

After a four month investigation the Elsmere Bureau of Police executed a search warrant in the 1900 block of W. Seneca Road, Wilmington this afternoon. With the assistance of Wilmington Police Department's K-9 Officer Steele and his partner Neo officers were able to locate the following:

- Approximately 400 grams of cocaine
- Approximately \$21,000 in US Currency
- One AR-15 Rifle
- One Glock 27 Handgun
- One Sig Sauer Handgun
- Numerous rounds of ammunition
- And other drug paraphernalia

During the search warrant officers took Antonio Glover (DOB: 8/4/77) of the 1900 block of W. Seneca Road into custody. The defendant was charged with the Possession of a Controlled Substance, Maintaining with the Intent to Deliver, Possession of a Deadly Weapon During by a Person Prohibited (3 cts) and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

The defendant was arraigned by Justice of the Peace Court #2 and was committed to the Howard Young Correctional Institute on \$76,200.00 secured bond.

Date of Occurrence: December 12, 2014 @ 0600 hrs.

In the early morning hours of Friday, December 12, 2014, Elsmere Police and Wilmington Police SWAT unit executed two search warrants for two individuals wanted in the connection of a double shooting that occurred in 2100 block of Seneca Road, Elsmere on September 15, 2014.

Reynaldo L. Diaz (DOB: 5/13/90) was apprehended at his residence in the unit block of Court Drive, Wilmington. Diaz is being charged with Attempted Murder 1st, Assault 1st, Possession of a Firearm During the Commission of a Felony (2 cts)., Possession By a Person Prohibited and Carrying a Concealed Deadly Weapon. In addition, he was charged with two counts of Possession of a Controlled Substance for 42 grams of cocaine and 58.59 grams of heroin, Possession Ammunition by a Person Prohibited, Possession With the Intent to Deliver, Possession of Marijuana and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

While officers were conducting the search warrants they located approximately 4,000 bags of Heroin, 42 grams of cocaine, marijuana and drug paraphernalia.

Diaz was arraigned by Justice of the Peace Court #2 and committed to the Howard Young Correctional Institution on \$456,300 cash bond.

Date of Occurrence: December 16, 2014 @ 0315 hrs.

On Tuesday, December 16, 2014, Cpl. John Mitchell responded to the 7-11 located in the 2500 block of Kirkwood Hwy to assist the Delaware State Police with a burglary in progress. While in route, ReCom advised that the suspect was attempting to gain entry into the business. ReCom gave the description as a male wearing a gray hoodie, black pants and a black back pack.


Upon arrival to the area, Cpl. Mitchell observed a male matching that description running north bound across Kirkwood Hwy into the Roselle shopping center. Cpl. Mitchell stopped the subject and held him until assisting officers arrived. The subject was found to have a back pack full of burglar tools, ski mask and black gloves on him. The subject was charged with attempted Burglary, Criminal Mischief, Wearing a Disguise During Commission of a felony and Possession of Burglar Tools.

Date of Occurrence: December 21, 2014 @ 2200 Hrs.

In the evening hours of Sunday, December 21, 2014, Elsmere Police officers executed a search warrant in the 2600 block of Speakman Place, Wilmington. As a result of a 6 month drug investigation, officers were able to locate 467 grams of hallucinogenic mushrooms and 442 grams of marijuana. A small amount of Dabs (a form of high grade hash usually made with a process involving butane), candy containing hash and \$5,705.00 USC were also seized from the residence.

Andre A. Corbitt was taken into custody at the residence and charged with Possession of a Controlled Substance in a Tier 5 quantity, Possession of a Controlled Substance in a Tier 1 quantity, Maintaining a Drug Property, Possession with the Intent to Deliver a Controlled Substance, and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. The defendant was arraigned by Justice of the Peace Court 11 and released on an \$8,000.00 unsecured bond.




Calls Per Day of Week
