Significant Events:

On the following dates/times Elsmere Bureau of Police officers seized the following drugs, money and weapons during the month.

January 5, 2015 @ 0130 hrs.:

Trespassing/Night Prowler Arrest

Sgt. Young and Cpl. Mitchell were dispatched to the area of the unit block of Richard Avenue for a report of a subject walking around trying door handles of parked vehicles. The officers parked their vehicles and checked the area on foot. While walking in the area they observed a subject walking in the roadway looking into parked vehicles. The subject was taken into custody without incident.

The subject confessed to officers he was walking around looking for change. The subject was identified as D-1 Anton Newkirk of the 1000 block of S. Grant Avenue.

D-1 was charged with Loitering (Night Prowling), Trespass Second Degree and walking in a roadway when sidewalk is provided. D-1 was released on O.R. bond.

January 29, 2015 @ 1030 hrs.:

Attempted Home Improvement Fraud to Senior Citizen

PFC Giles & PFC West were on patrol in the area of the unit block of Olga Road when they observed a suspicious subject standing on the sidewalk. The officers spoke with the male subject who stated he was from Virginia and was currently at a residence in the unit block of Olga Road for home repairs.

Upon further questioning the officer determined the subject did not have a Town of Elsmere business license which is required by all contractors.

A further investigation conducted by the officers reveal that all three defendants had conspired to attain payment from the victim for work they did not intend to complete and return to the Commonwealth of Virginia after cashing the victims \$7,600.00 check.

All three subjects were taken into custody and arrested on the below charges.

Defendant #1: Ronnie A. Jenkins of the 200 block of 4th Street Luray, VA was charged with Attempted Home Improvement Fraud of person 62 yrs or older, Conspiracy Second Degree-Agreement to Engage in Felony Criminal Conduct. Def #1 was also cited for Failure to obtain a business license with the Town of Elsmere.

Defendant#2: Michael Taylor of the unit block of Bristol Avenue Luray, VA was charged with Attempted Home Improvement Fraud of person 62 yrs or older, Conspiracy Second Degree-Agreement to Engage in Felony Criminal Conduct.

Defendant #3: Roy Wayne Sisk of the 6000 block of Slate Mills Road Boston, VA was charged with Attempted Home Improvement Fraud of person 62 yrs or older, Conspiracy Second Degree-Agreement to Engage in Felony Criminal Conduct. The defendants were arraigned before Justice of the Peace Court 2 and were each released on \$4,000.00 unsecured bail and were given a no contact order with the victim and the Town of Elsmere.

January 31, 2015 @ 1730 hrs.:

Search Warrant Yields Two Guns, Ammo & Marijuana

Elsmere Police executed a search warrant in the 200 block of Birch Avenue. After a three month drug investigation, Elsmere Police seized one Glock 17 handgun with a K.P.O.S. G2 P.D.W. Conversion-Kit Attachment, one Smith & Wesson M&P 9 mm handgun, 150 rounds of ammo, 19 grams of Marijuana and Drug Paraphernalia.

Jonathan Rosario was apprehended at his residence in the 200 block of Birch Avenue, Wilmington. Rosario is being charged with Possession By a Person Prohibited (2 cts), Possession of Marijuana and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. Rosario was released on \$6,300 unsecured bond.
