

June 5, 2015

While conducting multiple drug investigations in Elsmere, officers developed information that 33 year-old Aquilla Hardy was selling narcotics from her residence located in the unit block on Elsmere Boulevard. On June 5, 2015, Elsmere police officers executed a search warrant at Hardy's residence and took her into custody without incident. The search of the residence yielded approximately 14.7 grams of marijuana and drug paraphernalia. Officers discovered that Hardy also had a vehicle parked in front of the residence. A search warrant was executed on the vehicle which resulted in the seizure of approximately five (5) pounds of marijuana still wrapped and in the packaged box shipped from California. The street value of the marijuana is approximately \$5000.00. The quality of the marijuana would be considered low grade.

Hardy was charged with Possession with intent to deliver a controlled substance and possession of drug paraphernalia.



June 14, 2015

While conducting a drug investigation officers from the Elsmere Police developed information that Hakeem Nesbitt 25 year old male from the unit block of Cannon Drive located in Edgemoor was selling heroin. On June 14, 2015, Elsmere police officers observed Nesbitt on Kirkwood Hwy in a 2015 Chrysler 200. Nesbitt was pulled over for a traffic violation in the parking lot of the Elsmere WAWA (915 New Road) Officers observed that Nesbitt was acting nervous and discovered that he was currently on probation. Officers observed a large bulge in Nesbitt's pants pocket and while patting him down, officers found 130 bags of heroin inside of his pants pocket.

Nesbitt was charged with Possession of a Controlled Substance. Nesbitt was released after posting \$2,501.00 dollars secured bail.

June 30, 2015

On June 30th, members of the Elsmere Police Department addressing quality of life issues observed a black Chevrolet Impala commit a traffic violation and then attempted to elude police. Officers observed the passenger of the vehicle identified as 22 year old Tyree Robinson from the 900 Block of Ibiza Court exit the vehicle and attempt to flee on foot. Officers observed Tyree throw items under a parked vehicle and detained him. When the officers located the items they recovered 262 bags of heroin packaged for sale with a total weight of 3.93 grams. Mr. Robinson was charged with Possession of a controlled substance in a Tier 3 quantity, and Possession with intent to deliver. He was arraigned and issued a \$10,000.00 secured bail, which he posted and was released.
