

**ELSMERE POLICE DEPARTMENT**  
**Monthly Report**  
**November 2016**

**Significant Events:**

On the following dates/times Elsmere Bureau of Police officers handled the below incidents and seized the following drugs, money and weapons during the month.

**October 7 , 2016:**

On October 7, 2016, the Elsmere Police Department with the assistance of the Wilmington Police SWAT Team executed a search warrant in the 200 block of Linden Avenue and took 29-year-old Jason Godwin into custody. Jason had an outstanding warrant reference to an earlier dispute where he brandished a firearm. Jason was charged with Possession of a firearm by person prohibited due to previously being convicted of a violent felony, carrying concealed deadly weapon a firearm, aggravated menacing, possession of a firearm during commission of a felony, unlawfully dealing with a dangerous weapon and falsely reporting an incident. Jason was committed to the Howard Young Correctional Facility for failing to post \$54,000 cash bail.



### **October 18 , 2016:**

On October 18, 2016 at approximately 0005 hours, Ptlm. Kevin MacDowell found Joshua Rieley (18-year-old male from Georgetown, DE) and an unknown suspect acting suspiciously in the area of the 1500 block of Second Avenue. Ptlm. MacDowell was able to stop Rieley but the second unknown suspect fled the scene. Ptlm. MacDowell discovered Rieley is a Georgetown resident who were stranded in Wilmington and was breaking into cars to get enough money for a bus ticket. Rieley was charged with Burglary 3<sup>rd</sup>, Trespassing, Night Prowling, Theft, and Conspiracy. Mr. Rieley was issued a no contact with the Town and was committed to Howard Young Correctional Facility after failing to post \$1,000.00 secured bond.



### **October 29 , 2016:**

On Saturday October 29, 2016, Seasonal Officer's Vega and Mughirah stopped three subjects for trespassing on the railroad tracks in the 300 block of New Road. The officers observed that one of the suspects, Solomon Lee a 20 year old male from the 1600 block of W. 8<sup>th</sup> St. in the City of Wilmington, appeared to be carrying a rifle. While attempting to take Lee in to custody he began to resist causing minor injuries to one officer. Despite being injured Ofc. Vega was able to deploy his departmental issued taser. The officers were then able to take all three suspects into custody without further incident. A search of Lee revealed that he was in possession of a Mossberg .22 caliber rifle with 10 ammunition rounds, 16.3 grams of raw heroin, three fixed blade knives, and an orange mask. The total weight of the raw heroin is equal to over 1,000 bags.

A second suspect, Jacarvious Brown, a 19 year old male from the 1600 block of W. 8<sup>th</sup> St., was found to be in possession of an illegal butterfly knife. The third suspect, a juvenile male from Elsmere, who was already on home confinement, was arrested for trespassing.

Juvenile male (no picture) was arrested for Criminal Trespass 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree. He was committed to the New Castle County Detention Center after receiving secured bond.

Jacarvious Brown (pictured w/blue background) was arrested for Criminal Trespass 3rd Degree and Carrying a Concealed Deadly Weapon. He was issued a No Contact Order with the Town of Elsmere and released on unsecured bond.

Solomon Lee (pictured w/gray background) was arrested for Criminal Trespass 3rd Degree, Resisting Arrest with Force that Causes Injury, Possession of Heroin in a Tier 5 Quantity, Possession with the Intent to Deliver Heroin (2 counts), Carrying a Concealed Deadly Weapon (three counts), and Possession of a Firearm by a Person Prohibited. He was issued a No Contact Order with the Town of Elsmere and committed to Howard Young Prison for failing to post \$32,000.00 bond.
