Monthly Report
October 2014

Significant Events:

On the following dates/times Elsmere Bureau of Police officers seized the following drugs, money and weapons during the month.

September 15, 2014:

Elsmere PD and New Castle County PD responded to the 2100 block of Seneca Road for a report of two subjects shot. Upon arrival officers located two males with gunshot wounds. Both victims were transported to Christiana Hospital where they remain in critical, but stable condition.

Witnesses reported seeing a black male wearing a black hooded sweatshirt running E/B on S. Grant Avenue after the shooting.

At this time the investigation is pending.

September 26, 2014:

Cpl. Mitchell conducted a motor vehicle stop for a cracked windshield. While speaking with the driver the front passenger was acting suspiciously and seemed very nervous. A Deljis check revealed that D-1 Dajuan Clayton was currently wanted out of the New Castle County Family Court. While securing D-1 into custody he attempted to swallow several baggies of Heroin. A total of 125 bags of heroin were recovered from D-1's pants. D-1 was charged with Possession of a Controlled Substance and Tampering with Physical Evidence. D-1 was arraigned by Magistrate Court #2 and received a total of \$4,000 unsecured bond.

September 27, 2014:

Elsmere officers conducted surveillance in the area of Driftwood Club Apartments on Greenbank Road on a suspected subject selling large amounts of marijuana. Officers observed were able to observe enough illegal activity to secure a search warrant. Officers seized the following: 424.4 grams of marijuana, 3 digital scales, 2 metal grinders, 13 glass bong, 3 plastic storage containers used to store marijuana, and 3 vacuum sealed bags.

September 28, 2014:

Elsmere officers executed a search warrant in 100 block of Bungalow Avenue. Upon arrival, officers encountered D-1 Roberto Rodriguez, D-2 Jacklyn McGraw and two other individuals. A search of the residence resulted in locating 14 bags of heroin, one hypodermic needle and one digital scale. D-2 (McGraw) was charged with the Possession of Drug Paraphernalia and D-1(Rodriguez) was charged with Possession of Heroin and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

D-1 was arraigned by Magistrate Court #11 and received a total of \$1,000 secured bond. D-1 did post bail and was released. D-2 received a total of \$1,500 secured bond. D-2 was unable to post bail and was transported to WCI as a result.
