## A RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE MEMBERSHIP OF SOME MEMBERS OF THE TOWN OF ELSMERE PENSION COMMITTEE.

**WHEREAS**, when Resolution 12 -01 which appointed the members of the Town of Elsmere Pension Committee was adopted it did not take into consideration how the police officer who was a participant in the secondary Pension plan or the employee of the Town would be appointed; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council wish to address those two appointed positions.

### NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ELSMERE, THE FOLLOWING:

- 1. Resolution 12-01 is hereby amended to read as follows.
  - a. That Section 1 V (Read): A member of the Department of Public Safety who is a police officer and who is a participant in the Elsmere Police Secondary Pension Plan, who shall be chosen by the members of the Department of Police Department; and
  - b. That Section 1(vi) (Read): An employee of the Town who is a participant in the Town of Elsmere Employee retirement plan who shall be appointed by the non-police employees of the town or if there are no participants in such plan, a third resident of the town selected by the Council who would qualify under item (iii) above.
